## **Important: Fraudulent Activity, Scams, and Unauthorized Use of Nomura Brand**

Nomura continues to monitor all unauthorized use of the Nomura brand. Such unauthorized use can include email scams and other types of illegal activity.

We recently became aware of a website [Nomuraonline.com](http://Nomuraonline.com) that may have been created in an attempt to fraudulently represent itself as being Nomura Bank (Luxembourg) S.A. **This website is not part of Nomura Bank (Luxembourg) S.A. or any other Nomura company.**

If you receive unsolicited communications, Nomura recommends that you contact our [Fraud Risk Officer](#) immediately to authenticate the content of any such communication. In addition, Nomura recommends that you do not:

- Make any payments without being certain the transaction is legitimate.
- Provide any personal information or data to anyone you do not know.
- Reply to suspicious emails or text messages or contact the sender.
- Open suspicious website links or attachments as this may lead to an attempt to infect your computer or mobile device with a virus.
