Together with our financial education character, Welbin, participants can have fun while deepening their financial knowledge through quizzes and personality tests related to money.

3. SDG Declaration

After learning about social issues and the role of money, children will make declarations regarding SDG challenges and their own actions.

Children will consider how money can help resolve various social challenges at schools, in their hometowns and globally. Six teams will present their ideas on stage on August 6 at 2:30 p.m.
