

## Nomura Announces Nomination of Members for Board of Directors

**Tokyo, March 28, 2025**—Nomura Holdings, Inc. today announced that the Nomination Committee resolved the Outside Director Nominees to be included in the proposals to the annual meeting of shareholders to be held in June 2025 to appoint members to the company's Board of Directors.

### Director Nominees

Together with the nominees announced on February 28, 2025, Nomura Holdings nominated a total of twelve directors. Of these twelve nominees, ten have been nominated to serve as Non-Executive Directors (including eight Outside Director Nominees), while the remaining two will serve concurrently as Executive Officers.
